Yupo Workshop Supply List:

- 1. YUPO paper (I'd like you to try big pieces, 11 x 14 is ok, but really the bigger the paper the easier it is, yupo is available on line (Jerry's Artorama, or Cheap Joe's) or at Dick Blick in Shadyside. (I use 144 pound 20" x 26")
- 2. watercolor paint or even thinned acrylic paints will work.
- 3. Brushes (I use a 1 Inch and 1/2 inch flat brush a lot) any flat or round brushes, but have some bigger ones
- **4. 3.5 inch foam sponge roller** (Ace hardware) a couple of them (I use these a lot)

optional stuff I'll be using (bring it if you have it):

watercolor pencils (if you have any) and a 2B pencil (I use Derwent intense ink watercolor pencils)

painter's tape (1/2 or 1 inch) and frisket

Old end of roll toilet paper roll with some paper on it (I use a plain one with no design)

little comb (a cheap hair one)

A little piece of small bubble wrap (4 x 4 inch or so)

paper towels

Magic eraser (like Mr Clean or other)

rubbing alcohol

white eraser

water container

a scraper, like an old credit card.

Have some reference photos of landscapes, street scenes, flowers etc to work from.
